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PARKING STUDY UPDATE

- Study concluded in August 2023
 - Conducted by Kimley-Horn
 - Involvement from faculty, staff, & students
 - Original study took place in 2018

- Phase 1 Recommendations:
 - Begin to restructure Auburn's Parking System- District zone approach.
 - Lowder Building District
 - Library Deck District
 - Campus Core
 - Athletics Complex
 - Rebrand Preferred Commuter Designations.
 - Launch hourly parking/paid visitor spaces.
 - Increase permit fees.



INCREASE PERMIT FEES

- Implementation Date: **Fall 2024**
 - Change: All permit prices increased by \$20



HOURLY PARKING AND PAID VISITOR SPACES

- Launch Hourly Parking/Paid Visitor Spaces
 - Implementation Date: **Spring 2025**
- Features:
 - ParkMobile app for payment
 - Price: \$2 per hr
 - No kiosks
 - Approximately 200 spaces
 - Locations:
 - Spaces that are currently under utilized
 - Stadium Deck
 - North Park Deck
 - South Quad Deck
 - Individual visitor spaces



REBRAND STUDENT PARKING DESIGNATIONS

- Rebrand Preferred Commuter Designations
 - Implementation Date: **Fall 2025**
- New Categories:
 - Eagle Lot (1, 2, 3, 4)
 - Coliseum lot, Arena lot, Village lot, Old Extension lots
 - Tiger Perimeter Zone
 - Hayfield and Overflow lot
 - Residential Reserved
 - Village resident parking deck, Hill resident lots, South Donahue resident parking deck
 - Does not increase student parking



NEW DESIGNATIONS FOR FACULTY/STAFF ZONES

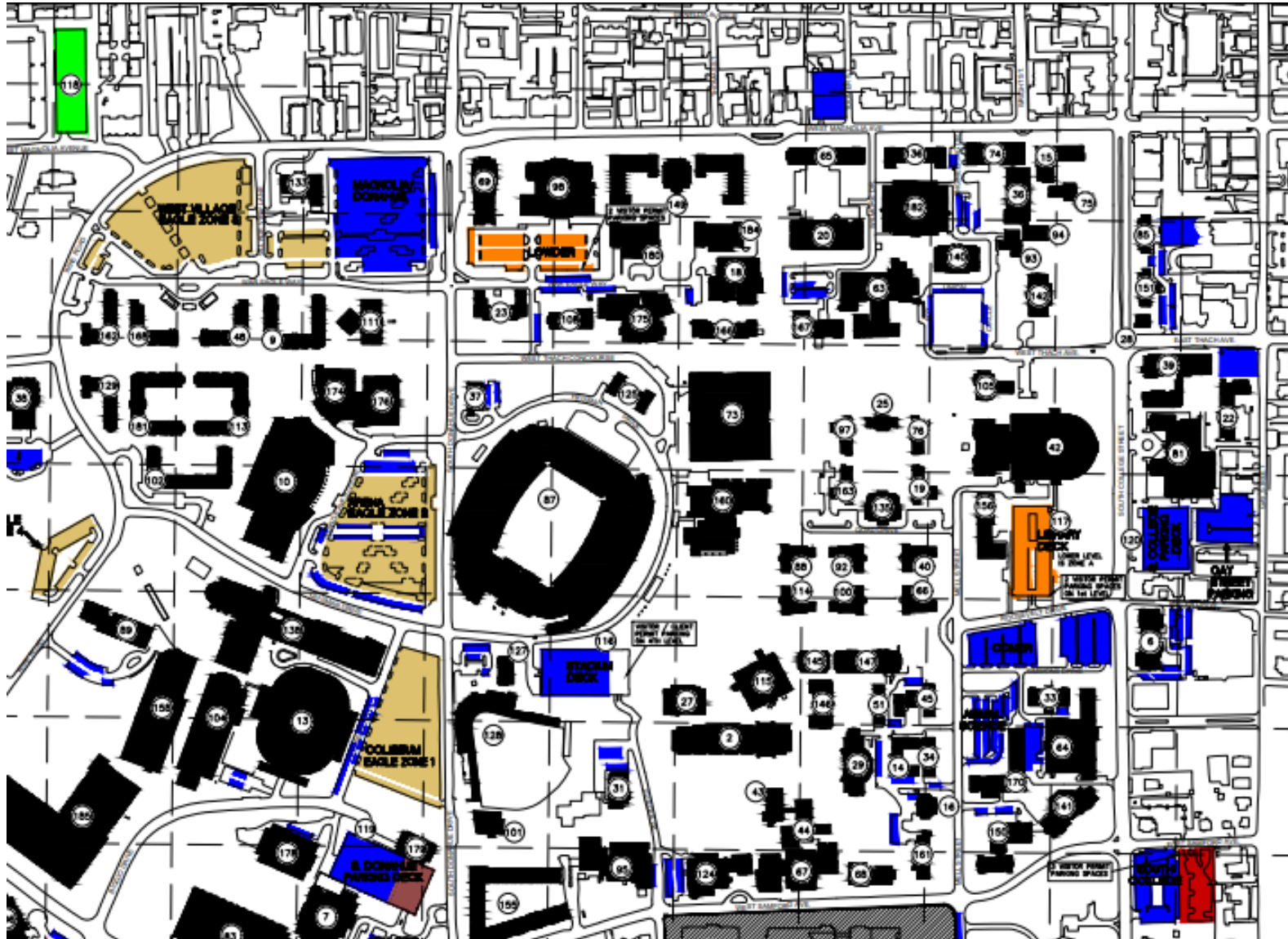
- Retire A/B Naming and Eligibility Requirements
 - Implementation Date: **Fall 2025**
- New Zones:
 - Faculty/Staff Orange Zone
 - Lowder and Library Deck
 - Faculty/Staff Blue Zone
 - Regular- Everything that is not Lowder/Library Deck
 - Tiger Perimeter Zone
 - Hayfield and Overflow Lot
 - Reduced price
- All faculty and staff will be eligible for orange and blue zones.



DISTRICT-BASED PARKING SYSTEM

- Restructure to a District-Based Parking System
 - Pilot: Fall 2025
 - Lowder Building District: Faculty/Staff Orange Zone, \$270/year
 - Valid in Lowder lot
 - Valid in all blue zones
 - Library Deck District: Faculty/Staff Orange Zone, \$270/year
 - Valid in Library deck
 - Valid in all blue zones
 - Restricted with fewer permits sold
 - Fall 2026 (if pilot succeeds)
 - Campus Core/Ross Square
 - Athletics Complex
- Faculty/Staff Blue Zone Pricing
 - Annual Cost: \$100
