## Administrative Survey Update

The Administrative Survey is the yearly survey of dept. chairs and deans. It does not include chairs and deans that are involved in a 3 or 5 year review through the provost's office.

The survey is given online with the option of a short one question survey or a longer more involved survey.

## Changes implemented over the last three years

- Two versions of the survey have been released, a shorter survey and a longer survey. This implementation was started four years ago and has proven very successful in raising the response rate.
- Moved to an earlier distribution date to get results to the provost's office in a timelier manner for the reviews.
- Tightened the wording on certain questions for clarity.
- Clarified the anonymity/confidentiality statement.
- Elimination of redundancy in questions.

## To raise the response rate, we explored way of alerting the university staff and faculty.

- One of the new changes is having the provost's office alert department chairs soliciting for more participation (Through Chase Bringardner's office).
- Announce at senate meeting in January. As representatives of your department/area you could encourage participation
- Moving the survey earlier as to not get lost in the clutter.
