

Faculty/Staff Tickets



Four main changes

- 1) Specifically addresses that policy violations are subject to Alabama Ethics Law and puts a “warning” early in the document,
- 2) Removal of outdated information,
- 3) Inclusion of gymnastics and softball in the policy (approved by the CIA in 2017)
- 4) Includes digital tickets and link to more information.

No Changes to...

- Who is eligible or ticket priority
- Seat selection process
- Away games and post season policy - Football
- The policy also still states:
 - D.3 Selling faculty/staff tickets at a profit is prohibited. Any individual violating said policy will be subject to penalties up to permanent loss of priority seating.

For YOUR use

- You receive these tickets at a discount – 80% of face value.
 - **They are intended for personal use and cannot be sold or traded at an amount greater than the price paid by the employee.**
- Violations can result in forfeiture of your ticket privilege!
- Selling your tickets for a profit constitutes using your public position for personal gain.
 - This is a violation of Alabama Ethics Law

Alabama Ethics Law

- To sell these tickets, which you are receiving in your role as an Auburn employee, for a profit is a violation of State of Alabama Ethics Law - Alabama Code 36-25-5.
- Auburn University officials investigate reports of any employee selling faculty/staff tickets for more than the price indicated on the ticket.
- Employees found to have profited from their faculty/staff tickets will be reported to the Alabama Ethics Commission, which can levy fines and criminal charges.
