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A QUICK REFRESHER

- SACSCOC requires universities to plan, propose and implement a five-year project aimed at enhancing student success.
- AUBURNACHIEVE is aimed at enhancing student post-graduation outcomes through unit-level interventions.
 - Post-grad outcomes are tracked and reported, annually
 - Bright Idea Seed Grant Program





WHERE DOES THE DATA COME FROM?

FIRST DESTINATION SURVEY

- All students are enrolled in Achieve the Creed in their final semester.
- The First Destination Survey (FDS) opens to students in the last two weeks of the semester.
 - 98% of students complete this survey





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GRADUATION

First Destination Survey (FDS) runs for the final two weeks of each semester



First destination outcome data finalized and shared with campus and NACE



NOVEMBER

National Clearinghouse Student graduate enrollment data requested



2 MONTHS POST-GRADUATION

First destination data request sent to all academic colleges



SIX-MONTH FOLLOW-UP PROCESS



Final follow-up survey Final phone calls



3 MONTHS POST-GRADUATION

Initial follow-up survey sent to anyone who did not indicate Full Time, Military, or Graduate School on the FDS






OVERALL POST-GRAD OUTCOMES - GR DEGREE EARNERS




OVERALL POST-GRAD OUTCOMES - GR DEGREE EARNERS

SATISFACTION



- the success rate to be at or above 92% for employment seeking graduates and 98% for continuing education seeking graduates.
- Salary to remain competitive with our southeastern and large research institution peers.
- 25% of graduate degree earners indicating that they have received 3 or more offers of employment and 85% of students indicating that they are in a job that they consider their top choice.





OVERALL POST-GRADUATION OUTCOME SUCCESS

- Outcomes steadily increased in the ten years prior to the pandemic, dipped slightly in 2020 and 2021, then returned to prepandemic levels in 2022.
- Outcomes associated with unit level interventions (Bright Idea seed grant) are being explored to better understand their impact on first destination outcomes.

HIGH IMPACT PRACTICE PARTICIPATION AND FIRST DESTINATION SUCCESS

Students completing an internship are nearly **2x** more likely to be successfully employed within six-months of graduation (Wilder, C. 2025).



ACHIEVEMENT

(Academics + Activities) Articulation

STEP 1

- Set-up meeting with Office of Academic Insight
- Discuss potential gaps in student outcomes
- Review outcome data for specific groups of students

STEP 2

- Submit 500-word abstract detailing:
 - Specific goals of project
 - Data informing the need for project

STEP 3

- Abstract review and feedback
 - Insight Lab
 - Community of Practice
 - Advisory Council

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BRIEF EXAMPLE:

"...aims to enhance **student career outcomes** by integrating emerging technologies into the classroom...Data shows that graduates from this program face challenges in securing employment, with employers citing a lack of experience with current technologies as a key barrier. To address this, the curriculum will be updated to include hands-on experience with tools such as ... Students will engage in project-based learning and benefit from industry partnerships offering internships and co-op programs. This initiative will equip students with the skills employers seek, improving post-graduation employment prospects and overall career readiness..."
